220-3-.82 Saltwater Angler Registry Regulation.

Any Alabama resident 16 years of age or older fishing in, attempting to fish in, or possessing fish taken from, those waters under the jurisdiction of the Marine Resources Division jurisdiction, as defined by Rule 220-2-.42(1) of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources as published in the Administrative Code, shall be required, between the dates of September 1 through August 31 of each year, to register in an annual Saltwater Angler Registry. This shall be a no cost registry. Registrations in this registry shall expire on August 31 of each year. This registration shall not be required by a person possessing a valid license issued under Code of Alabama 1975, 9-11-53.1,9-11-53.5, 9-11-54 or 9-11-56.3(b). This registration shall also not be required by persons fishing on a vessel that is licensed under 9-12-95, (Commercial Party Boat License).

Informational Note: In accordance with Section 9-1-4, Code of Alabama 1975, a violation of this regulation shall be a Class C misdemeanor.
