AMENDED RULE

Alabama Plumbers and Gas Fitters Examining Board

720-x-16-.01 Bad Checks.

If a check or negotiable instrument is dishonored, the writer of the check or instrument will be required to tender payment of the full amount of such check or instrument plus a service charge in the amount of \$30.00 (thirty dollars) as established by Section 8-8-15 of the Code of Ala. 1975.

- (1) If the dishonored check or instrument was tendered for the purposes of sitting for an examination, payment of the full amount of such check or instrument plus a \$30.00 service charge must be paid in full prior to the individual being allowed to take the said examination. If the individual has already taken the examination prior to the Board's office receiving notification of the dishonored instrument, the individual's results will be held until such time as payment is made in full including the \$30.00 service charge.
- (2) If the dishonored check or instrument was tendered for the purposes of renewing an individual license or certification, the license or certification is invalidated and will not be considered in good standing unless the issue is resolved within thirty (30) days.
- (3) If the dishonored check or instrument was tendered for the purposes of applying for a license or certification, the application will not be processed until such time as payment is made in full, including the applicable \$30.00 service charge.
