# CHAPTER 330-X-1 ORGANIZATION, ADMINISTRATION AND PROCEDURE

#### 330-X-1-.14 Authority of Rules.

- (1) Rules of procedure adopted by the Board shall be binding upon persons certified and/or licensed under Title 34, Chapter 11 Code of Alabama 1975 and shall be applicable to corporations holding a certificate of authorization.
- (2) Rules of procedure adopted by the Board shall be binding upon applicants seeking certification and/or licensure under Title 34, Chapter 11 Code of Alabama 1975 and shall be applicable to corporations applying for a certificate of authorization.
- (3) Rules of procedure adopted by the Board shall be binding upon non-licensed individuals and corporations who are deemed to be offering and/or performing services as outlined in Title 34, Chapter 11 Code of Alabama 1975.
