APPLICATION TO THE STATE ELECTION BOARD FOR ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF CITIZENSHIP FOR VOTING PURPOSES (Form C-4)

Complete and submit only if applicant has not submitted satisfactory documentary proof of citizenship. If applicant has already been denied registration but believes that he or she has submitted documentation that complies with the stated requirements, then applicant's remedy is appeal to the Probate Judge.

- (7) A consular report of birth abroad of a citizen of the United States of America.

- (9) A certification of report of birth issued by the United States Department of State.

- (10) An American Indian card, with KIC classification, issued by the United States Department of Homeland Security.
- (11) A final adoption decree showing my name and United States birthplace.
- (12) An official United States military record of service showing my place of birth in the United States.
- (13) An extract from a United States hospital record of birth created at the time of my birth indicating the applicant's place of birth in the United States.
- (14) Federal confirmation of U.S. citizenship under 8 U.S.C. §1373.
