**AGENCY NAME:** Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators

RULE NO. & TITLE: 135-X-5-.06 (1) – Grading Examinations

**INTENDED ACTION:** Amend the above referenced rule.

**SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:** The Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators proposes to amend Rule 135-X-5-.06 by changing the passing test scores effective January 1, 2014 and July 1, 2014:

"Each applicant for a Category I or II assisted living administrator's license shall be required to pass Sections A and B of the examination for such license with a grade as determined by the Board. The Board has determined that Section A and Section B of the Category I or Category II State examination will be used for the written or oral examination administered to all applicants, and the applicant must obtain a score of at least 80% on each section of the Category I or Category II State examination. Effective January 1, 2014 all applicants must obtain a passing score of at least 85% on each section of the Category I or Category II State Examination. Effective July 1, 2014 all applicants must obtain a passing score of at least 90% on each section of the Category I or Category II State Examination." All applicants who apply and are approved by the Board through reciprocity shall be required to take Section A of either the Category I or Category II examination, determined by the license for which the applicant has applied. The applicant must obtain a score of at least 80% on Section A of the Category I or Category II State examination. Effective January 1, 2014 the applicant must obtain a score of at least 85% on Section A of the Category I or Category II State Examination. Effective July 1, 2014 the applicant must obtain a score of at least 90% on Section A of the Category II State Examination.

TIME, PLACE, MANNER OF PRESENTING VIEWS: The Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators will hold a public hearing to hear oral and written comments from 10:00 am until 11:00 am on May 24, 2013. The public hearing will be held in the conference room of the ALAA Office, 5921 Carmichael Road, Montgomery, Alabama.

(4) If a Category I applicant wishes to obtain a Category II license, he or she must complete the application process and pass Section A of the Category II examination. If the Category II applicant has completed the 30 hours of AIT training within the previous 12 months of his/her Category II application, then he/she shall be exempt from taking Section B of the Category II examination.

- "Each applicant for a Category I or II assisted living administrator's license shall be required to pass Sections A and B of the examination for such license with a grade as determined by the Board. The Board has determined that Section A and Section B of the Category I or Category II State examination will be used for the written or oral examination administered to all applicants, and the applicant must obtain a score of at least 80% on each section of the Category I or Category II State examination. Effective January 1, 2014 all applicants must obtain a passing score of at least 85% on each section of the Category I or Category II State Examination. Effective July 1, 2014 all applicants must obtain a passing score of at least 90% on each section of the Category I or Category II State Examination." All applicants who apply and are approved by the Board through reciprocity shall be required to take Section A of either the Category I or Category II examination, determined by the license for which the applicant has applied. The applicant must obtain a score of at least 80% on Section A of the Category I or Category II State examination. Effective January 1, 2014 the applicant must obtain a score of at least 85% on Section A of the Category I or Category II State Examination. Effective July 1, 2014 the applicant must obtain a score of at least 90% on Section A of the Category I or Category II State Examination."
- (2) The Board shall determine a method of grading each section of the examination separately and shall apply such method uniformly to all candidates that are examined.
- (3) An applicant who does not pass a section of the Category I or Category II Assisted Living Administrator Licensure examination may pay another examination fee and retake the appropriate section of the examination. After failing the same section of the examination twice, the applicant will be required to participate in a Board approved study course before taking the section of the examination a third time.
