165-X-14-15-01 Non-Sanctioned Events.

165-X-14-15 Non-Sanctioned Events.

(1) Any Amateur Mixed Martial Arts Sanctioning Organization licensed by the state or the Amateur Mixed Martial Arts Sanctioning Organization's personnel shall not participate in events not sanctioned by a tribal or state commission. Any Amateur Mixed Martial Arts Sanctioning Organization who participates or has personnel participating in a show not sanctioned by an approved state or tribal commission shall be subject to disciplinary action.

(2) Any licensed amateur mixed martial artist, professional mixed martial artist, or professional boxer participating in a boxing or mixed martial arts event not sanctioned by an approved tribal or state commission shall be suspended for a minimum of 60 days pending a hearing. Any unlicensed participant in an event not sanctioned by an approved tribal or state commission shall be listed as a violator of this rule in the national database for 60 days. Violators may not participate in any event licensed or sanctioned by the Commission for 60 days.

(3) For the purposes of this rule, an approved tribal or state commission is one recognized by the Association of Boxing Commissions.

(4) Any commission going through the recognition process of the Association of Boxing Commissions shall not have the participants of their event suspended or reported to the national database if the event meets the requirements to the satisfaction of an official Association of Boxing Commissions representative supervising the event.
