- (1) A fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per request plus \$.03 per printed page shall be charged for requests for privilege license information and a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be charged for requests for regulatory automotive dismantler license and buyer's identification (BID) card information. Law enforcement agencies and other federal, state, county, and municipal agencies of all jurisdictions who reciprocate with information and/or assistance to the Alabama Department of Revenue shall be exempt from the payment of this fee.
- (2) All persons who request privilege/regulatory license or BID card information from the Severance & License Tax Section of the Natural Resources Business and & License Tax Division, Alabama Department of Revenue, shall apply in writing. Payment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) by via certified funds per request should be submitted with the request for privilege license information. The \$.03 per printed page fee will be paid after printing but prior to mailing.
