395-X-I-.02 Nomination and Appointment. In October of each year, a meeting shall be held in Montgomery for the purpose of nominating eligible candidates to serve on the Board. Nominations are taken for Districts One (1), Two (2), and Five (5) on even numbered years and Districts Three (3), Four (4), Six (6), and Seven (7) on odd numbered years. Three nominees from each district shall be selected and their names submitted to the Governor, who shall appoint one person from each district. No more than two nominees from each district can be of the same race. New members are sworn in at the first regular meeting following December 31 of the respective year. If an appointment is not made before the expiration of the term of a board member, then the board member may continue to serve until a successor has been appointed.

395-X-1-.03 Meetings. The Board shall meet at least once quarterly for the purpose of administering examinations for funeral directors and/or embalmers and for conducting Board business. Special Meetings may be called by the Board or the executive secretary to deal with matters that require immediate attention.
