# 395-X-4-.01 Original Inspection of Funeral Establishments.

(a). Before a funeral establishment may open for business:

- 1. An inspection of the premises must be made by one of the Board's staff or its members to verify that the establishment is in compliance with all rules and laws.
- 2. The establishment must obtain a current business license from the county or city municipality where the establishment is located.
- (b). The Board shall charge a fee of one hundred fifty (150) dollars for the first inspection and one hundred fifty (150) dollars for any re-inspection necessitated by failure to meet minimum requirements in the first inspection.
