Rule No. 560-X-52-.05 Qualifications of Staff Who Will Serve As Review Team for Medical Assistance

- (1) The nurse shall be a graduate of a licensed school of nursing with a current state certification as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) or Registered Nurse (RN). This person shall have knowledge and training in the area of mental retardation or related disabilities with a minimum of two (2) years' nursing experience.
- (2) The social worker shall be a graduate of a four-year college with an emphasis in social work. This person shall have knowledge and training in the area of intellectual disabilities mental retardation or related disabilities with a minimum of two (2) years' social work experience.
- (3) The psychologist shall be a Ph.D. in Psychology. This person shall be a licensed psychologist with general knowledge of test instruments used <u>for individuals</u> with intellectual disabilities with the mentally retarded or related disabilities with a minimum of two (2) years' experience in psychology.
- (4) Other professional disciplines which may be represented on the assessment team as necessary depending on the age, functional level, and physical disability of the clients are as follows:
 - (a) Special Education,
 - (b) Speech Pathologist,
 - (c) Audiologist,
 - (d) Physical Therapist,
 - (e) Optometrist.
 - (f) Occupational Therapist,
 - (g) Vocational Therapist,
 - (h) Recreational Specialist,
 - (i) Pharmacist,
 - (i) Doctor of Medicine,
 - (k) Psychiatrist, and
 - (1) Other skilled health professionals
