# 810-5-1-.224 Fee Requirement for Certain Special Tags. (REPEALED)

(1) WHEREAS, certain tags are issued to individuals free of the regular tag fees, and

WHEREAS, some of these individuals desire to purchase "special" tags (Example; Amateur Radio, Personalized, etc.), which tags required an additional fee, the following procedure is hereby adopted.

- (2) Any individual, who is entitled to the free regular tag fees for passenger cars and pickups up to 8,000 pounds, who wishes to purchase a "special" tag may do so by paying the additional fee required under the specific section providing for such tag, if purchased on an annual basis (Example: \$3.00 for the Amateur tag or \$50.00 for the Prestige tag).
- (3) If purchased on a monthly declining basis, only the appropriate number of months fees shall be credited and collected to license the individual's vehicle to his month of renewal.
