220-2-.60 Airboat Regulation.

- (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to use an airboat on any of the public waters of this State in Baldwin or Mobile counties that are subject to the ebb and flow of the tide of at least two (2) inches, between November 15th of each year and the end of the waterfowl seasons. in the area of operation.
- (2) The prohibition prescribed in Paragraph (1) above shall not apply to the use of airboats by State or Federal game wardens law enforcement personnel, state aquatic plant management personnel, acting in their official capacity nor by oil and gas exploration crews, or utility company personnel while operating air boats in their official capacities.
