- 420-1-5-.08 <u>State Level Fees</u>. Notwithstanding any rule provision previously adopted by the State Board of Health, pursuant to <u>Code of Ala. 1975</u>, § 41-1-11, the Department of Public Health shall collect fees for the services as set out below.
 - (1) Bureau of Environmental Services
 - (a) Lead Hazard Reduction Contractor Certification
 - 1. Initial Application Fee -- \$300
 - 2. Annual Renewal Fee -- \$240
 - 3. Replacement Certificate Fee -- \$30
 - 4. Project Fees:
- a. Residential Dwelling Unit. \$120 per residential dwelling unit covered by the project notification for project of 1 to 5 dwelling units up to \$600. For projects exceeding 5 residential dwelling units, the fee shall be \$600 plus 2% (.02) of the contract (project) cost covered by the project notification but not to exceed \$12,000.
