

140-X-3-.01 Requirements For Issuance. The application for licensure must be completed on the prescribed forms, a signed Physician/Athletic Trainers Protocol Consent Form, requisite fees paid, and proof of certification by the Board of Certification, Inc.

(1) Executive Secretary will ~~acknowledge receipt of~~ receive applications for licensure ~~to registrant~~ and inform registrant of information needed to complete the application, if any.

(2) Upon receipt of an application for licensure meeting the requirements for issuance and not requiring further consideration by the Board as determined by the Executive Secretary, the Executive Secretary will ~~acknowledge receipt to registrant and extend permission~~ issue a license on behalf of the Board ~~to begin practicing pending further review and~~ subject to final approval by the Board.
