SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: (1)220-2-.151-To further regulate conduct at certain archery ranges and parks; to add names of additional archery parks; to further provide for the use of bows and arrows; and to provide for additional posted restrictions; (2)220-2-.126-To further regulate conduct at certain public shooting ranges; and to provide for additional posted restrictions; (3)220-2-.22-To further provide for the names, boundary lines, and maps of certain wildlife management areas, refuges, and a sanctuary; to also list certain Federal refuges in Alabama; and to repeal existing rule; (4)220-2-.35- To further provide for the creel, possession and size limits for certain fish; and to restrict the taking of, and to require the release of certain, species on certain areas; (5)220-2-.110-To further provide for and establish certain physically disabled hunting areas; to revise maps; to rename a certain area; and to add an additional area and map; (6)220-2-.11-To further provide for prohibited methods and devices for hunting; and to provide for a certain exception for certain range finders on bows.

#### 220-2-.151 Archery Range Regulation

- (1) It shall be unlawful to shoot any type of bow or crossbow on the Athens Community Archery Park, the Cullman Community Archery Park, <u>Demopolis Community Archery Park</u>, <u>Dothan Community Archery Park</u>, or any other archery range operated now or in the future by the Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries, except in accordance with the following rules. All range users shall abide by the posted rules. Permits for excepted uses will be issued by the Hunter Education Coordinator or his designee. The range may be closed as necessary.
  - (a) The range is open during daylight hours only, except by permit.
  - (b) No alcoholic beverages allowed.
  - (c) Arrows may only be nocked onto the bowstring when standing on the shooting line preparing to shoot.
  - (d) Shooting allowed only from the shooting line and only into the designated targets.
  - (e) Shooters are allowed to bring and shoot at a paper face placed on an existing target as long as it is removed from the range once an individual has finished shooting. Personal targets are not allowed on range, except by permit.
  - (f) Bows must be hung on the bowhanger behind the shooting line when waiting to shoot or while archers are down range retrieving arrows. No shooting shall be allowed while anyone is down range.
  - (g) All persons are to remain behind the shooting line while shooting is taking place.
  - (h) Arrows from bows of 30 pound draw weight or more may only be shot into the targets on the adult range. Arrows from bows less than 30 pound draw weight may be shot into targets on the youth or adult range.
  - (i) Only arrows with field or target points may be used or possessed on range. No broadheads may be possessed on the range, except by permit.
  - (j) All individuals standing on or utilizing the elevated platform must wear a full body harness, including shoulder and leg straps, and attach themselves to the appropriate safety cable carabineer.
  - (k) All used paper target faces and other trash shall be placed in a trash receptacle or removed from the range.
  - (l) Use of Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries archery ranges is limited to the following persons: All Alabama residents 16 through 64 years of age are required to have a valid state hunting license, a valid state wildlife management area license, or a valid wildlife heritage license. All non-residents 16 through 64 years of age are required to have a valid state hunting license or a valid state wildlife management area license.
  - (m) Bows will only be drawn in such a manner as to prevent accidental or intentional loss of an arrow from range property. Arrows will only be released into designated targets.
  - (n) It shall be unlawful to violate any posted restriction.
- (2) The penalty for the violation of any of the provisions of this regulation shall be as provided by law.
