Fees of the Board shall be in the following amounts:

- (a) The application fee shall be as provided in Code of Ala. 1975, §34-17-25(1).
- (b) The fee for examination shall be set by the Board each year upon notification of the purchase price of the examination from the Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards. The fee established by the Board shall cover all costs of examination, but in no event shall the fee exceed the actual cost of preparing and administering the registration examination.
- (c) The fees for each section of the examination for reexamination shall be set by the Board each year upon notification of the purchase price of each section of the examination from the Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards. The fees established by the Board shall cover all costs of examination, but in no event shall the fee exceed the actual cost of preparing and administering the registration examination.
- (d) There shall be no fee for the supplemental examination. (b) The fee for the supplemental examination shall be \$150.
- (e) (c) The fee for the original certificate shall be as provided in Code of Ala. 1975, §34-17-25(3).
- (f) (d) The fee for a duplicate certificate shall be as provided in Code of Ala. 1975, §34-17-25(4).
- (g) (e) The annual license fee for residents of the State of Alabama shall be as provided in Code of Ala. 1975, §34-17-25(5).
- (h) (f) The annual license fee for nonresidents of Alabama shall be as provided in Code of Ala. 1975, §34-17-25(5).
- (i) (g) The penalty fee shall be as provided in Code of Ala. 1975, §34-17-25(6).
- (j) (h) The annual license fee for a certificate of authorization for corporations or partnerships shall be \$50.00.
- (k) (i) The fee for the original certificate of authorization for corporations or partnerships shall be \$50.00.
