Fees needed for licensing and examinations, renewal of licensing and other services of the Board are payable in advance to the executive director of the Board. Current amounts will be indicated where practicable upon appropriate forms or schedules or made available by the Board upon request. The Board hereby adopts and establishes the following fees:

 - (a) Application fee not to exceed \$300.00.
 - (b) Facility renewal fee not to exceed \$100.00 \$200.00.
 - (c) Penalty for late renewal of license 2x renewal fee \$200.00

 - (a) Additional copies of the Veterinary Practice Act \$15.00 \$30.00.
