NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

RULE NUMBER: 270-X-2.12

TITLE OF RULE: Maintenance Of Controlled Substances Records And Inventory.

- (1) Beginning on January 1, 1983, every Every dentist certified to dispense controlled substances by the Board of Dental Examiners of Alabama shall be required to maintain an accurate inventory and separate dispensing record of all controlled substances in Schedules II, IIN, III, IIIN, IV and through V dispensed in their his/her offices. The inventory shall account for all controlled substances obtained or received by the dentist's office or the dentist regardless of whether the said controlled substances were purchased or obtained at no cost. The dispensing record shall contain the following information:
 - (a) The date the controlled substance was dispensed;
 - (b) The method by which the controlled substance was dispensed (i.e., administered in office or released to patient);
 - (c) The name of the controlled substance dispensed (trade name or generic name);
 - (d) The name of the patient to whom the controlled substance was dispensed; and
 - (e) The quantity of the controlled substance dispensed.
- (2) The inventory and separate dispensing record required by this rule shall be kept in the office of the dentist for a period of five (5) years from the date the controlled substances are dispensed and shall be made available for inspection by agents of the Board of Dental Examiners of Alabama or any law enforcement agency.
- (3) Failure to maintain and make available the inventory and separate dispensing record required by this rule shall be considered a failure to maintain effective controls against diversion of controlled substances into other than legitimate dental channels.
- (4) Whenever any dentist desires or is required to dispose of any controlled substances located in his his/her office, he he/she shall do so in accordance with the procedure for the disposing of controlled substances established by the Drug Enforcement Agency or pursuant to any rules or regulations promulgated by that agency.
