## NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

RULE NUMBER: 270-X-5.09

TITLE OF RULE: Non-Disciplinary Administrative Penalties.

Any dentist or dental hygienist dentist/dental hygienist who is found to be in violation of the following requirements of the Alabama Dental Practice Act shall have imposed a non-disciplinary administrative penalty in the amount set forth below:

- (1) As to dentists only, failing to renew their DEA registration within one (1) year of the expiration thereof.
- (2) As to dentists only, any practice owner who allows a dentist or dental hygienist dentist/dental hygienist to practice without a current annual registration permit.
- (3) As to dentists only, by failing to comply with the provisions of Code of Alabama (1975), Sade of Alabama (1975), \$34-9-15.1.
- (4) Failing to timely renew any license or permit required pursuant to the Alabama Dental Practice Act and performing activities which require the applicable license or permit during the time the same was expired.
- (5) Failing to comply with the provisions of Board Rule 270-X-4.04. In addition to the applicable penalty, the licensee shall be required to make up the number of deficient hours by December 31 thirty-first (31st) of the following renewal period.
- (6) The penalty for a violation by dentists shall be up to five hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$500.00) \$500.00.
- (7) The penalty for a violation by dental hygienists shall be  $\underline{\text{up to two hundred dollars and } 00/100}$  (\$250.00) \$250.00.
- (8) Failure to pay the penalty within the time prescribed by the board Board, unless otherwise notified, will result in disciplinary action.
- (9) A dentist or dental hygienist dentist/dental hygienist shall not qualify for the non-disciplinary administrative penalty referenced above for more than two (2) violations occurring within five (5) years of any prior application of this rule.
