610-X-11-.01 Candidate Qualifications

Applicants for graduate nursing scholarships shall:

- (1) Be a resident of the State of Alabama for at least one year preceding the time of making application for the graduate nursing scholarship.
 - (2) Have an active, unencumbered license as a professional nurse in Alabama.
 - (3) Be a person of good character.
- (4) Be accepted for an Alabama graduate program conducted by an accredited college or university.
- (5) Agree to practice professional nursing or become a nursing instructor in the State of Alabama for at least two years after completing the graduate degree. The scholarship recipient may apply to the Board of Nursing for a waiver from these requirements for extenuating circumstances beyond the control of the recipient.

610-X-11-.02 Scholarship Conditions

- (1) Scholarships may be awarded for multiple years of graduate study.
- (2) The Board shall give preference to applicants pursuing a career in nursing education.
 - (3) Each scholarship is limited to a maximum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
- (4) Scholarship recipients shall be selected from the State of Alabama at large, and to the extent practicable, distributed throughout the State.

- (5) The number of scholarships shall equal five percent of the total enrollment in graduate nursing programs in Alabama.
- a. Each June Board staff will contact deans of Alabama graduate nursing programs to determine the total number of Alabama residents enrolled in graduate nursing programs.
- b. The Board shall use the number of Alabama residents enrolled in graduate nursing programs to determine the number of scholarships to be awarded.
- (6) Scholarship recipients are required to attend the specified graduate program for a minimum of six (6) academic hours for at least two consecutive semesters during the year of scholarship funding.
- (7) Scholarship recipients shall notify the Board if any of the following conditions apply:
 - a. Failure to complete the graduate nursing program when anticipated.
 - b. Relocation.
 - c. Employment following graduation from graduate nursing program.
- d. Failure to attend a minimum of six academic hours for at least two consecutive semesters during the year of scholarship funding.
 - e. Withdrawal from graduate nursing program.
 - f. Failure to maintain a "C" average in nursing courses.

610-X-11-.03 Application for Scholarship

- (1) An applicant for the graduate nursing scholarship shall submit a typed application by the deadline established by the Board.
 - (2) Incomplete applications may not be considered.
 - (3) The applicant for graduate nursing scholarship shall submit proof of:
 - a. Residency.
 - b. Acceptance in graduate nursing program in Alabama.
- (4) Once awarded a scholarship, the applicant shall sign a promissory note for the total amount awarded.

610-X-11-.04 Failure to Satisfy Conditions of Scholarship

- (1) A scholarship recipient who fails to meet the conditions of the scholarship shall immediately repay the State Treasury in full any amount received.
- (2) In the event of the scholarship recipient's death, any obligation to repay funds shall be cancelled.
- (3) Should the scholarship recipient becomes physically or mentally impaired and is unable to complete a graduate degree in nursing or fulfill the post-scholarship service requirement, the obligation to repay funds shall be cancelled.

610-X-11-.05 Payment of Scholarship Funds

Payments to the scholarship recipient shall be made semi-annually.

(2) The first payment shall be after January 1 of the year of funding, provided the recipient submitted documentation to prove six hours of academic study and a minimum of a "C" average.

(3) The second payment shall be made after July 1 of the year of funding, provided the recipient submitted documentation to prove six hours of academic study in two consecutive semesters and a minimum of a "C" average.
