610-X-11-.01 Candidate Qualifications. To be eligible to receive a post-baccalaureate nursing scholarship, a registered nurse shall:

- (1) Have been a resident of Alabama for a period of one year immediately preceding application.
 - (2) Have an unencumbered Alabama registered nurse license.
- (3) Hold a baccalaureate degree in nursing from an accredited nursing school.
- (4) Have been admitted to a graduate program seeking a master's or doctorate degree in nursing or nurse anesthesia in an accredited school of nursing in Alabama.
- (5) Submit to the Board prior to June 1 of proposed year of study a completed application, including required documents of certification, recommendation, and character reference.

610-X-11-.02 Scholarship Conditions. A post-baccalaureate scholarship recipient shall:

- (1) Practice nursing for at least one year in Alabama immediately following completion of the graduate program.
 - (2) Attend school on a full-time basis during the year of scholarship funding.
- (3) Complete course of study for which scholarship was approved within a reasonable length of time. In no event shall this period extend beyond 4 semesters after the scholarship funding ceases unless specifically authorized in writing by the Board.
- (4) Submit, prior to September 1 of year of scholarship funding, a signed promissory note and agreement to fulfill obligations or repay funds.
- (5) Keep the Board informed of the status of the above conditions and immediately inform the Board of the failure of any of the conditions.
 - (6) The Board may modify or extend the conditions on an individual basis.

610-X-11-.03 Selection of Recipients.

- (1) Completed applications \underline{may} be considered by the Board at the first regular meeting after June 1.
- (2) Should more than fifteen applicants meet the scholarship requirements the Board shall select recipients from the various geographic areas of the state and may establish other priorities as needed.
- (3) Each year scholarships may be either renewed or awarded to another applicant.

610-X-11-.05 Failure to Comply with Conditions.

- (1) If the recipient fails to continue full-time study, to complete the program, or to practice nursing in Alabama for one year following completion of the program, as set out in the Scholarship conditions, the recipient shall repay the entire amount of any scholarship funds received to the State Treasury.
- (2) In the event of mental impairment, physical impairment, or death rendering the recipient unable to fulfill all conditions, the debt to the State Treasury representing all funds disbursed and not repaid may be canceled.
