832-X-11 Inspection of Licensees

- 1) Inspections may be initiated by the Board at any time during normal and reasonable business hours after licensure, which may include but are not limited to determining compliance with the rules governing licensees. Failure to cooperate with such inspection may lead to disciplinary action by the Board.
- 2) During an inspection, the Board may review security officer personnel records to ensure officers are in compliance with licensing and training.
- The Board may review training records and criteria to ensure the company is incompliance with the training requirements set forth in Chapter 832-X-1-.08. The Board may also review trainers employed with the security company to ensure compliance with licensing requirements set forth in Chapter 832-X-.07.
- 4) The Board may review any documents of the security company or business pertaining to the compliance with the Alabama Regulatory Security Board Statute, § 34-27C-1 (3), Code of Ala., 1975
