## 100-X-5-.06 Construction Administration.

- (1) On a project where a building permit has been issued and the sealingan Alabama registered architect has not been engaged, or is no longer engaged, to perform at least minimum construction administration services, as defined in subsection (a) below, the sealing architect must report to the building official and the Board that he or she has not been, or is no longer, so engaged.
- sealing an architect deemed necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public shall beinclude but not necessarily limited to periodic site observations of the construction progress and quality, review of contractor submittal data and drawings, and reporting to the building official and owner any violations of codes or substantial deviations from the contract documents that the architect observed. As with other architectural services, qualified employees of registered architects may perform construction administration services under the instruction and responsible control of their employers.
