**TIME, PLACE, MANNER OF PRESENTING VIEWS:**



Proposed Rule Change

720-x-16-.01

**720-x-16-.01 Bad Check.** If check or negotiable instrument is dishonored, the writer of the check or instrument will be required to tender payment of the full amount of such check or instrument plus a service charge of \$30.00 as established by section 8-8-15 of the Code of Alabama 1975.

(1) If the dishonored check or instrument was tenured for the purpose of sitting for an examination, payment of the full amount of such check or instrument plus a service charge of \$30.00 must be paid in full prior to the individual being allowed to take the said examination. If the individual has already taken the examination prior to the Board's office receiving notification of the dishonored instrument, the individual's results will be held until such time as payment is made in full including the service charge.

(2) If the dishonored check or instrument was tenured for the purpose of renewing an individual ~~license or certification, registration, or payment of fines or penalties~~, the ~~license or certification or registration~~ shall be invalid and will not be considered in good standing unless the full amount of such check or instrument plus a service charge of \$30.00 is paid within (30) days.

(3) If the dishonored check or instrument was tenured for the purpose of applying for a ~~license, certification, or registration~~, the application will not be processed until such time as the payment is made in full, including the applicable \$30.00 service charge.
