AGENCY NAME: Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center (ACJIC)

RULE NO. & TITLE: 265-x-2-.03 (Individual Access, Review and Challenge of Criminal History Record Information), and Appendices A (Applicant Application), B (Instructions for Completing Request for Review of Criminal Records) and C (Criminal History Record Challenge).

<u>INTENDED ACTION:</u> The Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center proposes to amend 265-x-2.03 and Appendices A, B and C.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The above rule as amended would clarify the procedure for an individual to access, review and challenge their Alabama criminal history record information maintained by the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center through the state's computerized criminal history repository (CCH) system. The rule would establish a one-year time frame for a person to challenge their criminal history record information (CHRI) review provided by ACJIC, and a one-year retention period for ACJIC to maintain CHRI review request. The rule also provides detailed criteria for the individual to provide in the event of a CHRI record challenge.

The above rule also would include revisions to Appendices A, B and C, which includes amending the Applicant Application (Appendix A) to include a revised, more detailed Application to Review or Challenge AL Criminal History Record Information, requiring the applicant to provide a copy of a valid photo identification with an application, and adding a legal reference to the criminal offense for a false submission under Alabama law; amending Appendix B to include revised detailed instructions for completing the application to review or challenge AL Criminal History Record Information; and the revision of Appendix C *from* the Criminal History Record Challenge form *to* Instructions for Law Enforcement Officials taking applicant fingerprints and a sample of the FBI's most recent "Applicant" Fingerprint card.

# 265-x-2-.03 Individual Access, Review and Challenge of Criminal History Record Information.

An individual about whom the <u>Alabama Criminal Justice Information</u>

<u>Center (ACJIC)</u> maintains criminal history record information (CHRI),
has the right to review such information and to challenge any portion
of the CHRI he or she believes to be inaccurate or incomplete.

- (a) Request to Review CHRI.
- 1. To review CHRI maintained by ACJIC, the subject of the CHRI must complete the "Request to Review Criminal Records" application to review or challenge AL criminal history record information provided by ACJIC (see Appendix A). This form application may be obtained online at www.acjic.alabama.gov, or by writing to the Director of the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center at its current mailing address in Montgomery, Alabama.
- (b) All parts of the <u>form</u> <u>application</u>, including a fully classifiable set of the <u>applicant's fingerprints</u> (see <u>Appendix C</u>), must be completed <u>according to the instructions provided by ACJIC</u> (see <u>Appendix B</u>).
- (c) An administrative fee of \$25.00 must be returned to ACJIC with the properly completed form application and the required fingerprints and documentation. Personal or business checks are not acceptable. The \$25.00 fee should be in the form of a cashier's check or money order made payable to the State of Alabama.
- 2. Review of CHRI. Upon proper identification of the applicant's CHRI maintained by ACJIC, a copy of the said record will be mailed, by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the address on the applicant's request form application.
  - 3. Challenge of CHRI.
- (a) Should the applicant believe that the CHRI maintained by the ACJIC is inaccurate or incomplete, he or she may, within one calendar year of the date of the ACJIC response to the applicant's CHRI application, challenge the inaccurate or incomplete CHRI by completing the application to review or challenge AL criminal history record information provided by ACJIC a form entitled "Criminal History Record Challenge" and returning it with the required information and supporting documentation to the ACJIC.

- (b) A copy of the  $\frac{\text{form "Criminal Record Challenge"}}{\text{mill be provided to the applicant with a copy of his or her CHRI.}$
- provided by ACJIC, the applicant must state what he or she believes to be the correct information include, at a minimum, the following details on each item being challenged. If possible, the applicant should include a copy of his or her CHRI provided by ACJIC that is being challenged, and should cite and, when possible, include official documents to support each item challenged the challenge.
  - i. The charge and DATE of each specific arrest or disposition being challenged;
  - ii. The Name of the ARRESTING AGENCY OR COURT for each arrest or disposition being challenged;
  - iii. A listing of each specific arrest or disposition being challenged;
  - iv. The details related to why each specific arrest is being incorrect or incomplete;
    - v. What the applicant believes to be the correct information for each arrest or disposition being challenged;
  - vi. Where the applicant obtained what he/she believes to be the correct supporting information (if applicable); and
  - vii. Official documentation from the arresting agency or court (if applicable) to support each arrest or disposition being challenged.
- (b) An individual's challenge to his/her CHRI maintained by ACJIC will be maintained by ACJIC for one calendar year of the date the challenge response is mailed to the applicant by ACJIC. After that date, a new application to review or challenge AL criminal history record information provided by ACJIC must be submitted in the manner required.
  - 4. Review of Challenged CHRI.
- (a) The ACJIC Director shall designate an agency official to review any challenge to CHRI maintained by ACJIC.
- (b) All documentation concerning the challenged CHRI will be forwarded by ACJIC to the agency originally having custody or control of the specific record(s) being challenged;

- (c) Should the agency originally having custody or control of the  $\operatorname{record}(\underline{s})$  determine the challenged CHRI to be inaccurate or incomplete, it shall purge, modify or supplement said CHRI as appropriate, and notify ACJIC.
- (d) The ACJIC shall inform the individual filing the challenge to CHRI of the action taken by the reviewing agency. Should the challenged CHRI be purged, modified, or supplemented, any agency or individual receiving said CHRI from the ACJIC during the previous 90-day period shall be forwarded a copy of the corrected record ACJIC shall inform the originating agency, ACJIC shall notify the Alabama Bureau of Investigation's Identification Unit and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, as appropriate, of the correction.
  - 5. Administrative Appeal.
- (a) Should the agency having original custody or control of the challenged CHRI decline to purge, modify, or supplement the challenged record, or should the individual believe the agency's decision to be otherwise unsatisfactory, the individual he or she may appeal to the ACJIC Commission.
- (b) The Administrative Appeal  $\underline{request}$  is perfected by notifying the ACJIC Director, in writing, of the intent to appeal.

The agency of record will be permitted to substantiate its decision on the initial challenge. If the Commission rules to correct or otherwise modify the CHRI, the agency of record will be notified. 

Under Alabama law and U.S. Government regulations, you have the right to review your criminal records criminal history record information maintained by the the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center. To review your record, you must complete the ACJIC Application to Review or Challenge AL Criminal History Record Information and mail it to the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center, P.O. Box 300660, Montgomery, Alabama 36130-0660 ATTN: Director.

An administrative fee of \$25,00 (twenty-five dollars) will be charged for each review. A certified check or money order in the amount of \$25.00 (twenty-five dollars) made payable to the STATE OF ALABAMA must be included in each request for review.

#### Instructions for Applicant

In order for your request to review, challenge or appeal your Alabama criminal history record information to be processed by the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center (ACJIC), you must complete the ACJIC Application to Review or Challenge AL Criminal History Record Information in accordance with the following instructions:

### 1. Your application must include a copy of one of the following forms of your own valid photo identification:

- a. A valid unexpired United States state-issued photo driver license or photo ID (non-driver) card;
- b. A valid unexpired United States Active Duty, Retiree or Reservist military ID card (DD Form 2 or 2A);
- c. A valid unexpired United States Military Dependent ID card (for spouse or children of Active Duty Military personnel);
- d. A valid unexpired United States Citizenship and Immigration Service Documentation, which may include either:
- i. Certificate of Naturalization N-550, N-570, N-578; or
- ii. Certificate of Citizenship N-560, N-561, N-645
  - e. A valid unexpired United States Passport; or
  - f. A valid unexpired Foreign Passport which meets the following requirements:
    - i. A foreign passport must contain a Valid United States Visa or I-94 to be used as a primary proof of identification; or

- ii. A foreign passport, not issued in English, must be translated and accompanied by a Certificate of Accurate Translation.

  Passports are not acceptable if un-translated into English and/or expired.
- 2. Your application must include the required \$25.00 administrative fee in the form of only a cashier's check or a money order made payable to the "State of Alabama" (sorry personal and/or business checks are not accepted).; and

Individual citizens may request, and may be provided with, classifiable sets of their own fingerprints to accompany a request for his/her own Alabama criminal history record information (CHRI) from the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center (ACJIC) in accordance with procedures established by the statewide ACJIC Commission in Section 265-X-2 of the Alabama Administrative Code.

One of the requirements in these procedures requires the individual to provide a classifiable set of his or her own fingerprints, taken by an authorized law enforcement agency with an FBI-issued ORI, with his or her application to Review or Challenge his or her own Alabama criminal history. This permits positive identification and insures that the proper criminal record is reviewed and/or challenged.

- 1. The individual you are fingerprinting should provide proper identification to your agency upon request.
- 2. This individual's fingerprints should be taken by law enforcement on an FBI "Applicant" Fingerprint Card (i.e. blue card). Please insure that your agency's name and ORI, AND your name and telephone number, are included on the completed fingerprint card.
- 3. Return the completed fingerprint card to the applicant, as it is the APPLICANT's responsibility to mail the completed CHRI request form, along with his/her own fingerprint card and the other required documents to:
