
INTENDED ACTION: Amend rule.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: This amendment provides an expanded explanation of continuing education requirements for an applicant for reinstatement of a lapsed registration.

(1) An architect who has allowed his or her registration to lapse for whatever reason must complete a new application, submit the application fee, renewal fee and late penalty, proof of 12 continuing education hours ~~(as provided by regulation)~~, and a sworn affidavit stating he or she has not performed any service included in the definition of the practice of architecture while not registered in the state of Alabama.

(a) Continuing education hours submitted with the application for reinstatement of registration may be earned either in the calendar year of reinstatement or in the immediately prior year.

(b) Continuing education hours submitted for reinstatement of registration may be applied to satisfy a continuing education requirement applicable to the first registration renewal following reinstatement but shall not be used to satisfy any continuing education requirement applicable to the second registration renewal following reinstatement.

(2) The Board shall review or authorize the Executive Director to review the application and authorize approval of the application for reinstatement. Should the application or record reflect disciplinary history or unsatisfactory responses to questions on the application, the Board will conduct a further review of the application and render a decision regarding eligibility for registration. If approved, the same registration number will be reissued. A new certificate for framing will not be issued unless a written request is received and the replacement fee is paid.
