**420-2-2-.10 Centralized Dispatch and Communications System.** Communications are critical to the function to of the Trauma System.

- (1) The Alabama TCC will be staffed 24-hours-a-day by personnel with specific in-depth knowledge of the Trauma System design, function, and protocols.
- (2) It will be the primary responsibility of the Alabama TCC to coordinate the Trauma System activities by maintaining the system, providing information and recommendations direction whenever needed to the field staff and hospital personnel in providing care to patients meeting the Trauma System trauma system entry criteria, and ensuring patients are routed to the closest and most appropriate hospital. Oversight of day-to-day operations of the Alabama TCC will be the responsibility of the Alabama TCC Operations Director.
