390-X-6-.04 Recertification Process [New Rule]

<u>INTENDED ACTION:</u> To repeal the existing rule and replace it with a new rule.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The existing rule regarding reciprocity would be repealed. In its place, a new rule would be promulgated which specifies the process through which certified prescribed burn managers may be recertified. This rule specifies that all continuing education requirements must be satisfied prior to expiration of the current certification. So long as this is done, individuals may apply for recertification up to one year after expiration of their current certifications. Otherwise, individuals must start the certification process anew.

### CHAPTER 390-X-6 PRESCRIBED BURNING CERTIFICATION AND PRESCRIPTION

#### 390-X-6-.04 Recertification Process [NEW RULE].

Submit an Application for Prescribed Burn Manager Recertification (FC-18B), proof of continuing education accomplishment, and a non-refundable recertification fee to:

Alabama Forestry Commission Attn: CPBM Program P.O. Box 302550 Montgomery, AL 36130-2550

In the event that a certified prescribed burn manager meets his/her continuing education requirement but fails to apply for recertification by his/her renewal date, he/she will be allowed a grace period of one (1) year to apply for recertification.

Certifications that have not been renewed within one (1) year of the expiration date will be considered nonrenewable and the burn manager must begin the process again by meeting the educational requirements for initial certification and reapplying for CPBM status.

Continuing education credits must be earned before the certification expires to be applicable for recertification purposes. Any continuing education credits earned after a certification expires will not be considered for meeting the educational requirements for recertification.
