## 265-X-1-.02 Organization. REPEALED

The Commission shall establish, develop, and continue to operate a center and system for the inter and intrastate accumulation, storage, retrieval, analysis, and dissemination of vital information relating to certain crimes, criminals, and criminal activity to be known as the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center. Central responsibility for the development, maintenance, operation, and administration of the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center was vested with the director of the ACJIC under the supervision of the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center Commission.

# 265-X-1-.02 Name Change NEW RULE

- (1) A reference in Chapter 265 to ACJIC shall be deemed a reference to the Information Bureau (IB) of ALEA. A reference in Chapter 265 to the ACJIC Director or Director shall be deemed a reference to the IB Director.
- (2) The ACJIC Commission was renamed the Alabama Justice Information (AJIC) Commission by Act No. 2013-67, Acts of Alabama, now codified as Code of Ala. 1975, §§41-27-1, et seq. A reference in Chapter 265 to the ACJIC Commission or to Commission shall be deemed a reference to the AJIC Commission.
