RULES OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH BUREAU OF DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

CHAPTER 420-4-3 INFECTED HEALTH CARE WORKERS

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420-4-3-.01 Purpose. The purpose of the Chapter is to provide for administration and implementation of the "Infected Health Care Worker Management Act (IHCWMA) to prevent transmission of Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV), and Hepatitis B Virus (HBV), and Hepatitis C Virus (HCV), or other disease designated by the State Board of Health to patients during invasive procedures.
