NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

RULE NUMBER: 270-X-2.22

TITLE OF RULE: Patient Records.

- (1) A dentist shall maintain complete treatment-records on all patients and <u>said</u> those treatment-records may include such information as the dentist deems appropriate but shall at a minimum include the following:
 - (a) Patient's full first and last name, address, and contact information and treatment date; and,
 - (b) Patient's nearest relative or responsible party;
 - (c) (b) Current health history, including chief complaint, if applicable, and a listing of all current medications; and,
 - (d) Diagnosis of condition;
 - (e) (c) The date treatment rendered. The type of treatment rendered. The reason for the treatment rendered and the name and/or initials of treating dentist and/or dental hygienist; and,
 - (d) Records of financial transactions should be retained or recorded; and,
 - (e) Applicable radiographs; and,
 - (f) Correspondence between treating dentist and any prior and subsequent dentists, physicians and/or referral sources/recommendations; and,
 - (g) Pathology reports.
- (2) When appropriate, records may also include but not be limited to:
 - (a) Treatment plan(s); and,
 - (b) Informed consent(s).
- (3) Records may be maintained in physical or digital format and may be disposed of in accordance with current American Dental Association (ADA) guidelines.
 - (f) Name and strength of any medications prescribed, dispensed or administered along with the quantity, date provided and authorized refills;
 - (g) Treatment plan;
 - (h) Applicable radiographs; and
 - (i) Patient's financial records and copies of all insurance claim forms.
- (2) Records may also include study models and other diagnostic aids.
