## 545-X-2-.08 - Expedited License

- (a.) Upon receipt of a letter of qualification as to a physician from a member state, and upon receipt of all allowed fees, the Medical Licensure Commission shall issue to such physician an expedited license.
- (b.) An expedited license shall be valid for a period consistent with the licensure period in Alabama and in the same manner as required for other physicians holding a full and unrestricted license within this state.
- (c.) An expedited license obtained through the Interstate Medical Licensure

  Compact shall be terminated if a physician fails to maintain a license in the state of principal licensure for a nondisciplinary reason, without redesignation of a new state of principal licensure.
