- (1) It shall be the duty of every organization sponsoring a contest, at its won expense, to have in attendance at each contest, a physician who has been issued by this Commission, and who has had not less than three years medical practice, whose duty it shall be to observe the physical condition of the boxers and advise the referee with regard thereto. No contest shall be allowed in which the difference in weight of the respective contestants shall exceed 18 pounds. This provision shall not apply to boxers in the heavy and light heavy-weight classes.
- (2) All boxers must be examined by a physician licensed by this Commission within eight hours of their entering the ring.
- (3) If a contestant is not physically fit to box, the medical examiner shall bar him from participation.
- (4) The physician shall examine and treat any contestant who appears injured, whether or not the injuries seem to be the cause of the termination of the bout.
- (5) The examination given contestants must be according to printed form prescribed by the Commission.

All licensed physicians must be residents of the state.

- (6) The Commission will use its own judgment as to the number of physicians to be licensed in any town or city and the Commission has the authority to designate the physician who will officiate at each contest or exhibition.
