220-6-.63 Three Mile Creek Vessel Restrictions

- (a) It shall be unlawful to operate a vessel with a combustible engine (gasoline or diesel powered) in the following area in Mobile County: from the headwaters of Three Mile Creek, to the railroad bridge at Telegraph Road. This prohibition shall not apply to law enforcement, government, or emergency vessels.
- (b) Any person violating any of the provisions of this regulation shall be punished as provided by §33-5-62, Code of Alabama 1975.
