RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ALABAMA 9-1-1 BOARD

CHAPTER 585-X-4 COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT OF SERVICE CHARGES

585-X-4-.04 Requirement of Annual Certification for Emergency Communication Districts

The Board may require each Emergency Communication District (ECD) in the State of Alabama to provide annual certification to the Board that the District is a valid and properly formed ECD and thus eligible for disbursements from the 9-1-1 Fund. If an ECD fails to provide the certification to the Board within the prescribed time, the Board may withhold disbursements from the 9-1-1 Fund to the ECD until such time as the certification is received by the Board.
