### Alabama State Board of Chiropractic Examiners Proposed Amended Rule

#### 190-X-5-.02 Cooperation With The Board.

- Statement of Policy. Each licensed chiropractor or permit holder is requested and is expected to cooperate with the Board in all matters.
- Report of Violations. Any chiropractor or permit (2) holder who has knowledge of violations of any provision of Code of Ala. 1975, §§34-24-120, et seq., or of these rules shall report such to the Board for investigation. When possible, the chiropractor or permit holder shall procure evidence that will aid in the prosecution of the violator. Failure to comply with the requirements of this rule will constitute unprofessional conduct as defined in Rule 190-X-5-.05, and Code of Ala. 1975, 34-24-166 (b) (2) (3).
