- 870-X-2-.07 Reciprocity. The Board, subject to the provisions of this chapter and the rules and regulations of the Board promulgated there under prescribing the qualifications of a speech-language pathologist and/or audiologist, may permit grant, at its discretion, any person who has successfully complied with the requirements of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) or an equivalent accrediting Association or Academy, and is a holder of a Certificate of Clinical Competence in speech-language pathology or audiology or its equivalent, or who holds a current license in another state in speech-language pathology or audiology may be granted a license according to the following conditions:
- (a) That the other state maintains a system and standard of qualifications and examinations for speech-language pathologists or audiologists which meet or exceed the current requirements for licensure in the state of Alabama.
 - (b) Payment of the current fee established by the Board for other licensees.
- (c) Submission of evidence satisfactory to the Board, i.e., proof of current out-of-state license.
