## 220-2-.140 Special State Park Hunting Seasons

There are hereby established Special State Park Hunting Seasons for the following parks:

- (1) Oak Mountain State Park Whitetail Deer Hunt. In a certain designated area at the park, for the hunting of deer by bow and arrow (including crossbows), during the period of November 1, 20142015, through January 31, 20152016, weekdays only, with the exception of the weekend of January 109 & 110, January 1716 & 1817, and January 2423 & 2524, 2015-2016, by permitted and licensed Alabama resident and non-resident hunters 16 years old or older only, subject to and in accordance with established registration and eligibility requirements. Stalk hunting only (no dogs). State harvest limits will apply. Hunters will be allowed to take up to three deer per day, only one of which may be an antlered buck.
- (2) <u>Lakepoint Resort State Park Whitetail Deer Bow Hunt. This is limited</u> to the following dates only: October 19-21, 2015, October 26-28, 2015, November 9-11, 2015, November 16-18, 2015, December 14-16, 2015, January 25-27, 2016, and January 29-31, 2016. The bow hunts are limited to four people per date/pre-registered and all state hunting regulations will apply, including state harvest limits in Barbour County.
- (3) <u>Lakepoint Resort State Park Youth Squirrel Hunt, gray squirrels only.</u> February 13, 2016 only. All state regulations apply, limited number and age class.
- (4) <u>Blue Springs State Park Youth Squirrel Hunt, gray squirrels only.</u> February 20, 2016 only. All state regulations apply, limited number and age class.
- (5) <u>Lake Guntersville State Park Alabama Hawking Association</u> <u>Demonstration Event, November 7, 2015 only. Gray squirrel harvest with raptors within the park golf course.</u>
