- (1) Any Permitted Interpreter or Transliterator in good standing who fails to renewal by April 29th of current renewal cycle may be granted reinstatement upon submission of renews a Permit within forty-five (45) days of the close of the current renewal cycle may be granted reinstatement upon submission of:
 - (a) Payment of reinstatement fee, renewal fee, and late fee.
 - (b) Documentation of completion of CEUs for every year a previous permitted has failed to renew or equivalent to 2.0 CEUs per year, and
 - (c) Permit application.
