# 680-X-2-.40 NON-DISCIPLINARY PENALTY FOR LATE RENEWAL OF LICENSE, OR PERMIT, REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATION, OR ANY SIMILAR DOCUMENT ISSUED.

- (1) In the event an application for renewal of any type of Pharmacy Permit, Pharmacist or Assistant License, Wholesaler, Manufacturer, Distributor Permit or Retail Oxygen Permit license, permit, registration, certification or any other similar document issued and required by the Alabama Pharmacy Practice Act, the Alabama Uniform Controlled Substances Act or any applicable Rule and the appropriate renewal fee is not received in the Board's office by December 31 of any even numbered the applicable year, but is received in the Board's office no later than January 31 of the following year, a non-disciplinary administrative penalty of fifty percent (50%) of the prevailing renewal fee must be paid by January 31 of the following year in order to renew. This penalty shall be in addition to the prevailing renewal fee.
