335-7-5-.18 Filtration Requirements. Treatment processes to include filtration are required when raw water quality from a groundwater source exceeds any of the following parameters:

- (a) Turbidity - 5.0 NTU
- Total Coliform 100 per 100 milliliter of sample (b)
- Fecal Coliform (or E. coli) 20 per 100 milliliter of sample (c)
- (d) Iron - 0.6 milligrams per liter
- (e) Manganese - 0.1 milligrams per liter
