355-4-1-.07 <u>State of Alabama ProcurementPurchasing/Credit Card Program</u>

- (1) The Division of Purchasing will establish and issue an Invitation-to-Bid (ITB) for a Procurement Purchasing/Credit Card-services program through a competitive solicitation process. The contract or contracts will be awarded based on the highest overall rebate amount offered to the State of Alabama in the bid. The rebate may be a single value or it may be a combination of two or more values. The resulting contract or contracts will be for a period not to exceed the maximum term set out in Section 41-16-27(e) of the Code of Alabama.
- (2) Notice of the ITB for the Procurement/Credit Card will be made to all Vendors which have registered to supply credit card services.
- (3) The evaluation of the bids submitted pursuant to this ITB will be conducted by a number of Buyers within the Division of Purchasing as determined and selected by the Director of Purchasing. Based on the evaluation, the Buyers will recommend one or more bids for award. The recommendation will be reviewed by the Director of Purchasing, then forwarded to the Director of Finance for final approval.
