## 700-X-4-.06 Discipline.

- (1) Restriction, Revocation or suspension of License. Upon a finding that respondent has violated any enumerated provision of Code of Ala. 1975, \$34-24-217, or any rule adopted pursuant thereto, the Board may restrict, revoke or suspend respondent's license to practice as a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant in Alabama.
- (2) Stay of Execution of Order. The Board may, in its discretion, permanently or temporarily stay the execution of its order to <u>restrict</u>, revoke or suspend respondent's <u>registration or</u> license. The stay may be conditioned on any provision the Board deems appropriate under all the circumstances of a particular case.
- (3) Considerations. In determining whether a registration or license should be restricted, revoked or suspended, and whether execution of the order should be stayed, and upon what conditions, the Board shall consider all relevant factors, including, but not limited to, the following:
  - (a) The severity of the offense;
  - (b) The danger to the public;
  - (c) The number of repetitions of offenses;
- (d) The length of time since the date of violation;
- (e) The number of complaints filed against the licensee;
- (f) The length of time the licensee has practiced;
- (g) The actual damage, physical or otherwise, to the patient;
  - (h) The deterrent effect of the penalty imposed;
- (i) The effect of the penalty upon the licensee's livelihood;

- (j) Any efforts of rehabilitation; and
- (k) Any other mitigating or aggravating circumstances.
- (4) Public Notice. The Board shall publish semi-annually a listing of names, with offenses, of licensees disciplined via formal or informal means.
