INTENDED ACTION: The Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy intends to amend Rule 30-X-4-.07.



Application And Examination Fees.

The non-refundable initial application fee for the Certified Public Accountant Examination shall be \$100.00. All subsequent applications to take the examination in whole or in part shall be submitted with a non-refundable application fee of \$50.00. Effective ~~September 1, 2008~~ September 1, 2011 the non-refundable examination fees shall be ~~\$235.00~~ \$215.00 for the Auditing and Attestation section, ~~\$225.00~~ \$215.00 for the Financial Accounting and Reporting section, ~~\$200.00~~ \$185.00 for the Regulation section, and ~~\$190.00~~ \$185.00 for the Business Environment and Concepts section. Examination fees must only be submitted for sections a candidate intends to schedule and sit for in the next six months because the authorization to test is only valid for six months after being approved. The non-refundable application fee for a Reciprocal Certified Public Accountant Certificate and Transfer of Credits shall be \$100.00 each.
