- (2) In addition to the powers granted under §§ 34-24-10600, et seq., Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, the Board or its agents are further authorized to conduct any investigation pursuant to its authority in § 34-24-361, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, including but not limited to, the conducting of formal interviews with a physician, the filing of a written administrative complaint and the request for the temporary emergency suspension of the license of a physician by the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama.
