The increase in examination fees collected is insignificant to the budget of the Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers. The change is necessary to cover the cost of the exam administration.

The Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors is statutorily required to operate as a self sustaining Board and relies on examination fees and licensure fees for revenue to provide for the operation of the Board. The slight increase in individual renewals and certificate of authorization applications/renewals will ensure that the operational expenses of the board are met.
