- Effective January 1, 2006 for Eeach registration or reregistration to manufacture controlled substances, the registrant shall pay a fee of six hundred dollars (\$600) to be renewed in even-numbered years.
- (b) Effective January 1, 2006 for Eeach registration or reregistration to distribute controlled substances, the registrant shall pay a fee of six hundred dollars (\$600) to be renewed in even-numbered years.
- Effective January 1, 2006 for Eeach pharmacy registration or reregistration to dispense controlled substances listed in Schedule II through V, the registrant shall pay a fee of three hundred dollars (\$300) to be renewed in even-numbered years.
- (d) Effective January 1, 2006 for Eeach pharmacist registration or reregistration to dispense controlled substances listed in Schedule II through V. the registrant shall pay a fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) to be renewed in even-numbered years. Upon verification of fifty (50) years of licensure in this state the renewal fee shall be no more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
