Renewal of Registration. The Board shall have the 100-X-2-.10 power to set renewal fees and fees for late payment. The Board shall issue renewal notices to each registered architect from the previous year to the last known address. Registration term is for the fiscal calendar year which begins October January 1 and ends September 30 December 31.of the following year. Renewals postmarked October January 1 through December March 31 will be considered late, and those renewals must include the late penalty established by regulation. All renewals must reflect completion of the current continuing education requirements established by the Board unless otherwise exempted. No provision is made for partial payment for a partial year. Renewal fees are due on December 31October 1st of each fiscal year. If the registrant elects to renew his license electronically, the registrant may be charged a convenience fee or surcharge. If renewal is not completed on or before March 31 January 1, the architect's registration will lapse and must be reinstated, as required by regulation.
