- 100-X-3-.04 Reporting. The continuing education section of the Board's renewal application must be completed in full in order to process the registration renewal. The registrant must supply enough detail on the form to permit verification of the continuing education hours.
- (1) Unless exempted as provided in 100-X-3-.02, each registrant shall submit the required continuing education information, which shall include an affidavit attesting to the registrant's fulfillment of continuing education requirements during the preceding\_current calendar year. No carry-over of continuing education hours is permitted. Failure to comply with these requirements shall result in non-renewal of the architect's registration.
- (2) Each affidavit shall be reviewed by the Board staff and may be subject to audit for verification of compliance with requirements.
