- The Board will conduct an audit of renewals submitted to ensure compliance with continuing education requirements. Registrants selected for audit will be notified and required to provide documentation in support of hours claimed.
- The Board may disallow claimed credit for continuing education hours if the CEHs do not comply with the above requirements. If continuing education hours are disallowed, the registrant shall have sixty (60) thirty (30) calendar days after notification to provide documentation that substantiates the original claim or provide documentation of other continuing education hours to meet the minimum requirements. Continuing education hours submitted to remedy a disallowance shall not be used for registration renewal purposes.
